CHRISTY KEARNEY AWARD NURSING and HOLISTIC HEALTH SCHOLARSHIP

Christy Kearney spent nearly 3 decades of her life devoted to the art of nursing. She was a compassionate community health nurse in SF during the early days of the AIDS epidemic and a tireless advocate for others in need. As a community nursing instructor at SFSU, she was revered by her students as an innovative, creative and devoted teacher. She spent the last 8 years of her life fighting a battle against breast cancer and discovered, firsthand, the power of holistic medicine.

The Christy Kearney Award in Nursing & Holistic Health scholarship is awarded each semester to a San Francisco State University School of Nursing undergraduate student who is engaged in community service, who has an interest in holistic health, and/or who is involved in research that focuses on pain management or cancer prevention, with preference to breast cancer. To be eligible for this scholarship the student must meet the following minimum criteria: maintain a 3.0 GPA, part-time enrollment in the nursing program; provide a statement of his/her professional goals, and provide a statement regarding need for the scholarship. Candidates will be reviewed and awards of \$500 to \$1000 will be made each semester. Application deadlines: Fall – October 25th, Spring – April 15th. Please deliver completed application to the School of Nursing BH 357 and mark “Confidential – CKA Scholarship Application.”
